Georgia's Top Shot Competition

at Creekside Firing Range

WHAT: A marksmanship competition utilizing weapons from the 16th century up through modern times.

WHEN: Day 1: January 28, 2012
Day 2: February 4, 2012
Day 3: February 11, 2012

WHERE: Creekside Firing Range in Taylorsville, Georgia

DETAILS: **Day 1** will consist of up to 100 competitors competing with 4 different weapons. Everyone will shoot the same course of fire with each weapon. The top 39% will advance to Day 2. The bottom 11% are eliminated. The middle group will have one head-to-head shoot-off with the winner's advancing to Day 2. The competitor with the "best run" with each of the 4 weapons will win that weapon.

Day 2 will consist of double-elimination head-to-head shoot-offs between competitors. Each competitor will shoot in a minimum of 3 shoot-offs. The top 16 competitors will advance to day 3.

Day 3 will push the final 16 shooters through various courses of fire ranging from 0 to 500 yards. Shooters will be eliminated until we reach the final 2. The final 2 shooters will compete in one final challenging course of fire using weapons from throughout all 3 days of competition.

The winner will be crowned Georgia's Top Shot and will receive a minimum of \$1000 in prizes.

Door prizes will be given out throughout the competition.

COST: \$30 to compete on Day 1
If you advance to Day 2 you will be required to pay another \$30
If you advance to Day 3 you will be required to pay another \$40
